If you think you are at risk of being HIV positive or have been diagnosed as a person living with HIV/AIDS, this free service will be invaluable to you.

Living with HIV/AIDS – three good reasons to join the programme

- 1. You will receive effective, appropriate and cost-effective medical care by qualified professionals.
- 2. You will be assisted in forming a support system.
- 3. A specialised care coach will assist you in developing life skills that will assist you in making decisions about your lifestyle.

We will provide you with professional and quality care to assist you in living with HIV/AIDS.

Will my privacy be respected?

Absolutely! No personal details are given to your friends, family or employers unless you give us written permission to do so.

Is the person managing my case adequately qualified?

- All our care coaches are highly specialised in HIV/AIDS counselling and case management.
- They are qualified professional nurses who are guided by experienced HIV/AIDS medical practitioners.
- This means that the very latest treatment and information will always be available to you.



What can I expect from the programme?

- Information and advice on treatment
- Counselling and continuous encouragement
- Information about the correct diet, vitamins and lifestyle to build your immune system
- Referral to healthcare providers who are experienced in managing HIV/AIDS
- Counselling and support to family/partners with your permission

- No personal details are ever given to your employer.
- A specialised care coach will explain the programme, as well as the benefits available to you.

What does the programme offer?

- Antiretroviral medication
- Blood tests related to your condition
- · Doctors' consultations
- If you are pregnant, treatment to help prevent your baby from contracting HIV
- Post-exposure prophylaxis medication if you are sexually assaulted or exposed to blood.



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
