# OPTION CHANGE FOR **2019**

Imperialmed has
two benefit plans, i.e. the
Imperialmed Health Plan, which has
existed from the inception of the Scheme in
July 1995, and the Imperialmed Budget Plan,
which was implemented on 1 July 2013.
Members have the option to change plans
once a year with effect from 1 January.

## BENEFIT CHANGES FOR 2019

Scheme Management herewith confirms that some of the benefit limits will be increased on both the Health and Budget Plans with effect from 1 January 2019. See some of the changes for 2019 below. The full 2019 benefit summary has been enclosed and may also be found at **www.imperialgroupmed.co.za**.



The following **preventative benefits** are available from 1 January 2019 and will be funded from **major medical expenses** (MME):

- human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccines
- pap smears
- mammograms
- prostate-specific antigen (PSA) tests.

The following new benefits are also included in your preventative benefits:

- DEXA (bone density) scans
- glaucoma screenings.

# Enhanced preventative benefits for 2019

	PREVENTATIVE BENEFITS	
	BENEFIT	DESCRIPTION
1.	Human papillomavirus vaccines (HPV) for all females	One treatment (prescribed dose) in a lifetime – major medical expenses (MME) at 100% of Scheme rate
2.	Pap smears	1 per beneficiary per year – MME at 100% of Scheme rate
3.	Mammograms	1 every 2 years for females who are 38 years old and older – MME at 100% of Scheme rate
4.	Prostate-specific antigen (PSA) tests	<ul> <li>1 every 3 years for males who are 30 to 59 years old</li> <li>1 every 2 years for males who are 60 to 69 years old</li> <li>1 every year for males who are 70 years old and older</li> <li>Paid from MME at 100% of Scheme rate</li> </ul>
5.	DEXA (bone density) scans	Limited to R1 800 and subject to 1 scan every 3 years for beneficiaries who are 50 years old and older – MME at 100% of Scheme rate
6.	Glaucoma screenings	<ul> <li>1 every 2 years for beneficiaries who are between 40 and 49 years old</li> <li>1 every year for beneficiaries who are 50 years old and older Paid from MME at 100% of Scheme rate</li> </ul>

# Additional changes applicable to the Imperialmed Health and Budget Plans

- 1. The current **deductable** of **R650** for specific procedures performed in hospital will increase **to R1 000 from 1 January 2019**.
- 2. The following procedures have been added under the deductibles for private and provincial in-hospital procedures: nail surgery, minor skin lesions, vasectomies, conservative back and neck procedures and circumcisions.
- 3. The deductable of **R1 000** in point 1 above will apply to in-hospital circumcisions as from **1 January 2019**.
- **4. BellyBabies** has been added to the antenatal classes from **1 January 2019** see more details in this newsletter.
- 5. Maternity programme the annual limit for ultrasounds has changed to the following: Two 2D or 3D or 4D per pregnancy up to 100% of the 2D scan at the Scheme rate.

# Additional changes applicable to the Imperialmed Health Plan only: Dentistry

- 1. Orthodontic treatment paid from the orthodontic benefit is for beneficiaries under the age of 21 years only.
- 2. Orthodontic treatment for beneficiaries over 21 years of age is subject to the specialised dentistry limit.



# BELLYBABIES

BellyBabies is an online antenatal course that is comprised of a comprehensive collection of short videos. The videos are presented by a wide range of experts in the maternity field and includes gynaecologists, midwives, medical doctors, dieticians, lactation experts, psychologists and anaesthetists. Supplementary course notes are also available for members to download.

The antenatal and postnatal classes run over a period of 18 months, thereby covering the first year of the baby's life. The classes provide information on pregnancy, birth and life after birth, as well as on an extensive range of subjects, from the benefits of natural birth and breastfeeding to bathing your baby, treating fevers and more.



Unlike traditional, face-to-face seminars, the BellyBabies online course has the following advantages:


- It can be done in the comfort and privacy of your home.
